### Old Testament

Job 19:23-27a	<i>I know that my Redeemer lives and I shall see God</i>
Isaiah 25:6-9	<i>The banquet of the LORD</i>
Isaiah 61:1-3	<i>Righteousness and praise flourish like a garden (61:1-4, 8-11)</i>
*Lamentations 3:22-26, 31-33	<i>Great is the LORD's faithfulness</i>
Daniel 7:1-3, 15-18	<i>The holy ones of the Most High shall receive the kingdom</i>
Wisdom of Solomon 3:1-9	<i>The righteous are with God</i>

### Psalms

+Psalm 23	<i>Though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I shall fear no evil; for you are with me; (23:4)</i>
Psalm 24	<i>They shall receive a blessing from the God of their salvation (24:5)</i>
Psalm 34:1-10,22	<i>Fear the LORD, you saints of the LORD. (34:9)</i>
Psalm 42:1-7	<i>My soul is athirst for God, athirst for the living God; when shall I come to appear before the presence of God? (42:2)</i>
Psalm 46:1-7	<i>The LORD of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our stronghold. (46:4)</i>
+Psalm 90	<i>Return, O LORD; how long will you tarry? Be gracious to your servants. (90:13)</i>
Psalm 91:9-16	<i>On eagle's wings – assurance of God's protection: Those who love me, I will deliver; I will protect those who know my name. (90:14)</i>
+Psalm 118	<i>Open for me the gates of righteousness; I will enter them; I will offer thanks to the LORD. (118:19)</i>
Psalm 121	<i>Behold, he who keeps watch over Israel shall neither slumber nor sleep; (121:4)</i>
+Psalm 130	<i>My soul waits for the LORD, more than watchmen for the morning (130:5)</i>
Psalm 139:1-12	<i>O LORD, you have searched me and known me. (139:1)</i>
Psalm 143	<i>LORD, hear my prayer, and in your faithfulness heed my supplications; answer me in your righteousness.(143:1)</i>
Psalm 149	<i>Sing the praise of the LORD in the congregation of the faithful (149:1)</i>
Ecclesiastes 3:1-2a; or 3:1-8	<i>For everything there is a season, and a time for every matter under heaven.</i>
