

Suggested Hymns for Liturgies of Christian Marriage

The marriage rite is a liturgy of the Church, celebrated by the local congregation who offer their witness and support to the couple and who, with them, seek God's blessings on this marriage. As such, only that which is appropriate for the worship of God is included in the wedding service. Music is chosen on the basis of Christian themes of faithfulness, self-giving love, and the seasonal context.
