Today's reading is from the Psalms:

<sup>1</sup>O come, let us sing to the LORD;  
let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation!  
<sup>2</sup>Let us come into his presence with thanksgiving;  
let us make a joyful noise to him with songs of praise!  
<sup>3</sup>For the LORD is a great God,  
and a great King above all gods.  
<sup>4</sup>In his hand are the depths of the earth;  
the heights of the mountains are his also.  
<sup>5</sup>The sea is his, for he made it,  
and the dry land, which his hands have formed.  
<sup>6</sup>O come, let us worship and bow down,
